Anjum Shahzad is presently pursuing his PhD in electromagnetics research group led by Professor Dr. Qaisar Abbas Naqvi at Department of Electronics QAU.

He obtained his MSc and MPhil Degrees in Electronics from QAU in 2005 and 2010 respectively. Upon scoring first position in MPhil, he was awarded by Chancellor's Gold medal. Afterward, from September 2010 to March 2011, he served as visiting faculty member at the parent department. He has published eight research articles in reputed international journals in the field of Electromagnetics under supervision of Professor Dr. Qaisar Abbas Naqvi.

He recently received international research support from HEC through the International Research Support Initiative Program (IRSIP) and is now proceeding to Zhejiang University (ZJU) China for a six-month visit to conduct collaborative research.

For the past two years, Anjum Shahzad has been the president of the SPIE student chapter QAU and actively participating in different trainings and outreach activities.
